Mr. Booher motioned to approve the Regular Meeting Minutes of July 28th, 2015 Council Meeting. Second by Mr. Zigerelli. Motion carried unanimously.

**Fiscal and Contractual**

Mr. Booher motioned to approve the Monthly Bills. Second by Mr. Zigerelli. Motion carried unanimously.

**Public Works Committee**

Danny Colville, Road Forman, reviewed the monthly Highway Report with Council. He stated that all the new roads signs have been installed; they have been working on crosswalk, the storm sewer project on Marshall Road, they have laid numerous tons of asphalt throughout town. He anticipates the street sweeper to be ran more frequently now that some of the larger projects have been completed. Mr. Leone stated that the new 2015 International Dump Truck is in the Borough parking lot for everyone to view after the meeting.

Curt DiGiovine, Waste Water Treatment Plant Superintendent, reviewed the monthly report with Council.

**General Government Committee**

Mr. Booher motioned to approve Ordinance No. 943/Floodplain Ordinance. Second by Mr. Zigerelli. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Booher motioned to hire Jennifer Katekovich as a part-time Police Officer at a rate of \$15.71 per hour. Second by Mr. Zigerelli. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Booher motioned to approve quote from U.S. Municipal in the amount of \$10,781.00 for snow plow and spreader for the 2015 International. Second by Mr. Zigerelli. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Booher motioned to approve Cricket Communications Contract termination. Second by Mr. Zigerelli. Motion carried unanimously.

### Monaca Volunteer Community Outreach Committee

Mrs. Majors, Chairman, stated that she and the children are continuing their weekly maintenance and is looking to clean up the hills if it is safe after spraying. She is pleased with after 4 years with the program she feels they were able to keep up with everything this year. Mr. Michel wanted to commend Mrs. Majors for all her hard work and dedication to the town.

### Downtown Business Authority

Mrs. Majors, Chairman, stated that the next meeting is scheduled for next Thursday. She wanted to update Council on the letter she received from Economic Development stating that Mr. Benyo does not qualify for the façade grant for his properties on Pennsylvania Ave. They do not feel it qualifies as blight. She is anticipating on contacting Mr. Benyo regarding the application. On October 10<sup>th</sup> a cash mob with the downtown businesses will be held. Mr. Leone added to Mrs. Major's report announcing that Pacentro's is planning on re-opening in their previous location.

### Manager's Report

Mr. Leone updated Council on the progress for the Reservoir garage and solar panel project and advised Council that an update from the Electrical Consultant for the Pumphouse was provided in their packet for their review. A follow-up meeting for the 17<sup>th</sup> Street Corridor is scheduled for tomorrow at 1:00 pm and the plans for the Antoline Park Pavilion project have been approved by MDIA and will now be moved to the next step of requesting bids for the work to be complete.

Owen Pella, Neighborhood Services Officer, provided to Council a report of the issues he has addressed and resolved in town to date.
