Mr. Booher motioned to approve Regular Meeting Minutes of February 10th, 2015 Council Meeting. Second by Mr. Michel. Motion carried unanimously.

Fiscal and Contractual

Mr. Booher motioned to approve Monthly Bills. Second by Mr. Zigerelli. Motion carried unanimously.

Building and Grounds/Recreation/Library Committee

Mrs. Rossi stated that the Committee discussed the renovations needed at the CJ Mangin building and has contacted the Historical Society and is waiting on a return call.

She also stated that the Recreation Board would like to contact Central Valley School pertaining to the Washington Ave. basketball courts regarding the needed repairs; possibly assisting in applying for a grant.

Water/Wastewater/Health and Sanitation Committee

Mr. Wilson stated that the Committee met last Friday and discussed water wells and the current situation at the Pumphouse. They also discussed the purchase of a machine to assist at the Waste Water Treatment Plant that can also be utilized at the other Borough departments.

General Government Committee

Council discussed the quote received from Golden Equipment Co. for repairs to the street sweeper.

Mr. McKay motioned to table the purchase of Panel Tree from Rileighs Décor in the amount of \$3,210.00. Second by Mr. Michel. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Booher motioned to approve Resolution No. 1-15, authorizing Council President and Borough Manager to sign Keystone Grant Agreement. Second by Mr. Michel. Motion carried unanimously.

Bob Mazinko, Beaver Ave., was in attendance to ask about the dilapidated houses on Beaver Ave.


