Mr. Nolder motioned to approve quote from Tuma Lawn Service for vegetation control in the amount of \$1,328.15 (Roadside-14th Street Hill, Cascade Road, Colonial Hill, Eckert Road and by the toll bridge \$782.75 Boat Launch \$318.15 brush hog Japanese knotweed at the boat launch \$227.25). Second by Mr. Snyder. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Snyder motioned to approve \$15,000.00 donation to the Monaca Public Library. Second by Mr. DiMarzio. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Shotter motioned to hire Andrew Golletti as Neighborhood Services Officer at \$1,500.00 per month, 25 hrs per week. Second by Mr. DiMarzio. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Wilson motioned to deny request from Kira George, tenant, Brad Lester, property owner, at 1105 Pacific Ave. an exception to fence permit application that was not in conformance with height restrictions. Second by Mr. DiMarzio. Motion carried unanimously and decision will be followed up with a letter stating that the fence needs to become into compliance or removed.


Citizens: Comments, Complaints, and Compliments
