Did you know, as a mandated community, the Borough of Monaca is required by Act 101 to recycle? But the Borough can't do it alone! We need your help to increase the amount of recyclable material collected at the curb. Statewide the recycling rate is over 35%, so let's do our part to catch up!

Recycling collection is made on a weekly basis on the same day as your regular trash collection. Recycling containers should be placed out with your trash containers. Be sure not to line your recycling containers with plastic garbage bags. All recyclable items may be co-mingled (mixed). Remember throwing recyclables in with your regular garbage is punishable by a fine of up to \$300.00.

Monaca Borough now has a dumpster for your use! The dumpster is located in the rear of the municipal building parking lot for your cardboard boxes. Please remember this dumpster is for recycling cardboard only. No trash is permitted!

BLUE RECYCLING CANS CAN BE PICKED-UP AT THE MONACA MUNICIPAL BUILDING, DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS (8 AM TO 4 PM), AT NO COST. Recycling containers can also be borrowed for your next special occasion. Call 724-775-9600 for availability.

RECYCLABLE ITEMS ACCEPTED	EXAMPLES	INSTRUCTIONS
PLASTIC- P.E.T.E.	#1,2,3,4,5,6 & 7 (the number on the bottom of the bottle inside the stamped recycle emblem): Pop bottles, cooking oil containers, peanut butter jars, juice bottles, etc.	Metal lids are to be removed and included with the recyclables. Plastic lids are to be removed and discarded with trash.
PLASTIC- H.D.P.E.	 #2: Milk and Water jugs, Cool Whip, juice, laundry, and vinegar containers, cleaning product bottles, 1 and 5 gallon buckets, etc.	All plastic lids are to be removed and discarded with trash.
GLASS	 Clear, green and brown beverage bottles, food jars, etc.	Metal lids and rings are to be removed and included with the recyclables. Plastic lids are to be removed and discarded with trash. Try not to break glass. We cannot recycle window glass, crystal, light bulbs, ceramics, Pyrex cookware, or drinking glasses.
STEEL CANS	 Beverage and food cans, both bi-metal (such as non aluminum pop cans) all steel cans such as soup or vegetable cans, etc.	Rinse containers
ALUMINUM	Beverage and food cans, pie plates, clean foil.	No paint or aerosol cans.
NEWSPAPERS & MAGAZINES		Please place newspapers and magazines on top of recycling can. Do not place paper in plastic bags
PAPER	 Junk Mail, Office Paper	Paper can also be recycled at one of the Abitaba Collection Containers located at the St. John's Church Parking lot on 15th St. & the Calvary Baptist Church Parking Lot on McClelland St.
CARDBOARD		Please break down boxes and bundle for collection.
CARDBOARD CARTONS	Milk and Juice Cartons
