Managers' Report: Mr. Kramer gave an update on the bond. The Borough will be getting \$6.7 million dollars in new money. He said they were very pleased with the sale and said Solicitor Urick could give more updates in his report. Mr. Kramer then mentioned rezoning of the 1<sup>st</sup> Ward requested by Edward Becker. He also met with the insurance adjuster for the pump station and the claim that was filed for the water issue a couple weekends ago.

VP Shotter recognized Mr. Kramer and Solicitor Urick for all their hard work for the sale of the bond and the new money the borough will soon be receiving. He then stressed about the Mask Resolution that was recently passed and that all borough employees, even council members who attend an event or are out and about need to make sure they and the other borough employees have their masks on to follow guidelines for the safety of all. Lastly, he asked a question about the rezoning of 1st ward and that they would provide costs to Mr. Becker once they received the information on rezoning that area.

<u>Solicitors Report</u>: Solicitor Urick gave a recap of the bond as well. He said they can discuss matters of the Oxendine case in Executive. Lastly, he also echoed his thoughts on the mask Resolution and to be sure that everyone is wearing them for the safety of the employees, the citizens and yourself.
