Monaca Borough Streetscape

ON TUESDAY, MARCH 12TH, 2024, BOROUGH COUNCIL VOTED TO ACCEPT THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE BID FOR OUR PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE STREETScape PROJECT (9TH-15TH STREET). THE OVERALL GOAL OF THE PROJECT IS TO SERVE AS A CATALYST OF GROWTH AND REVITALIZATION FOR OUR DOWNTOWN BUSINESS DISTRICT. SIGNS OF CHANGE HAVE ALREADY BEGUN ON PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE WITH PRIVATE INDUSTRY INVESTING IN OUR STOREFRONTS.

A PIVOTAL COMPONENT OF HAVING A THRIVING COMMUNITY IS THE INCLUSION OF A VIBRANT BUSINESS DISTRICT, AND WITH MANY OF THE PLANS IN PROGRESS, WE SEE THE UPWARD TRAJECTORY OF THESE CHANGES COMING TO OUR COMMUNITY. THE STREETScape PROJECT IN TOTAL WAS APPROVED FOR JUST UNDER \$6.7M WITH ALL SPENDING BEING BETWEEN BOND AND GRANT FUNDS.

TO MAKE A PROJECT LIKE THIS COME TO FRUITION, THE BOROUGH SECURED NEARLY \$3.4 MILLION DOLLARS IN GRANTS, WITH THE REMAINING PORTION BEING PAID OUT OF PROCEEDS FROM A BOND REFINANCE THAT HAS ALLOWED THE THE BOROUGH TO REALIZING ALMOST \$400K SAVINGS IN ANNUAL DEBT SERVICE PAYMENTS.

WE HAVE SEVERAL OTHER PROJECTS IN PROCESS THAT WE ARE EXCITED TO BE ABLE TO SHARE FURTHER DETAILS IN THE COMING MONTHS. WE HAVE BEEN ABLE TO SECURE GRANT FUNDING TO SUPPLEMENT THE BOND REFINANCE FOR MULTIPLE FUTURE PROJECTS IN TOWN SUCH AS A NEW FIRE DEPARTMENT BUILDING TO HOUSE THE MERGED DEPARTMENT, PENNSYLVANIA AVE/17TH STREET TRAFFIC IMPROVEMENT, UPGRADES TO ANTOLINE PARK AND OTHER PLAYGROUNDS, AND CONTINUED INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS SUCH AS ROAD PAVING AND WATERLINE REPLACEMENTS.

WE ARE VERY EXCITED TO SHARE THESE CHANGES AS THEY COME TO FRUITION FOR MONACA IN THE VERY NEAR FUTURE AND CAN'T WAIT TO CELEBRATE THE SUCCESSES WITH OUR RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS.

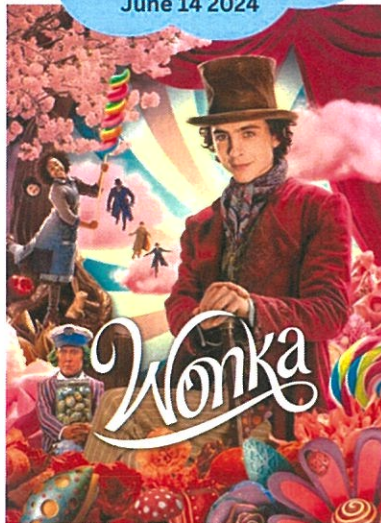
