

Ordinance No: 970

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONACA, BEAVER COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, REPEALING SECTION § 225-74 CONTAINED IN CHAPTER 225 ARTICLE X OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONACA AND REPLACING IT WITH A NEW SECTION 225-74 ENTITLED "PARKING RESTRICTIONS FOR STREET MAINTENANCE PURPOSES"

WHEREAS: Current Article X, Section 225-74 of the Code of the Borough of Monaca sets forth date and time restrictions for street cleaning purposes; and

WHEREAS: The Council of the Borough has experienced issues with respect to enforcement of the aforesaid Section 225-74; and

WHEREAS: The Council of the Borough has recognized issues, other than with street cleaning, with respect to maintaining streets, among other things, in areas of the Borough; and

WHEREAS: The Council of the Borough desires to repeal current Section 225-74 and replace it with a new more comprehensive and uniform way of maintaining borough streets and providing services thereon..

NOW THEREFORE be it ENACTED and ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Monaca and it is hereby ENACTED and ORDAINED by the authority of same.

Section 1: That Section 225-74 of Chapter 225 Article X of the Code of the Borough of Monaca is hereby repealed.

Section 2: Section 225-74 of the Chapter 225, Article X of the Code of the Borough of Monaca, shall hereinafter read as follows:

§ 225-74 - Parking Restrictions for Street Maintenance Purposes

A. Except as noted below Street Maintenance will be conducted on the following streets or parts of streets in accordance with the following schedule, between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., during which time:

1. The parking of vehicles is prohibited on Mondays on the side of all Borough streets bearing addresses ending in an odd numbered digit; and
2. The parking of vehicles is prohibited on Tuesdays on the side of all Borough streets bearing addresses ending in an even numbered digit.

3. Exception: The parking of vehicles is prohibited on Indiana Avenue from 9th Street to 15th Street on Mondays on the side bearing addresses ending in an even numbered digit and on Tuesdays on the side bearing addresses ending in an odd numbered digit.

B. Notice of the aforesaid restrictions shall appear on posted signage.

C. For purposes of this section "Street Maintenance" shall mean any one or more of the following actions or services that can be taken or directed to be taken, from time to time, by or on behalf of the Borough:

- 1) Snow removal.
- 2) Leaf pickup.
- 3) Garbage pickup.
- 4) Road repair/upkeep.
- 5) Catch basin repair/upkeep.
- 6) Water and/or sewer line repair/upkeep.
- 7) Line painting.
- 8) Signage repair/upkeep.
- 9) Street sweeping.
- 10) Street light replacement/upkeep.
- (11) Telephone or cable tv line repair/upkeep that the Borough is required by law to perform.
- 12) Sidewalk repair/upkeep that the Borough is required by law to perform.
- 13) Waterline/hydrant repair/upkeep.

D. The words "parking" or "parked" as used in this section, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, shall mean:

- (i) The temporary storage of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, off the roadway; or
- (ii) The halting of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except momentarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading property or passengers.

E. The word "vehicle" as used in this section, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, shall mean:

- (i) Every device in, upon, or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a roadway. The term does not include a self-propelled wheelchair, or an electrical mobility device operated by and designed for the exclusive use of a person with a mobility related disability.

F. Violations and Penalties:

The penalties for violation of this section shall be as set forth in §225-55 of Chapter 225, Article IX of the Code of the Borough of Monaca.

Section 3: Repealer:

All Ordinance(s) or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the specific provisions of this Ordinance only, are repealed hereby.

Section 4: Effective Date:

The provisions of the Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption hereof.
